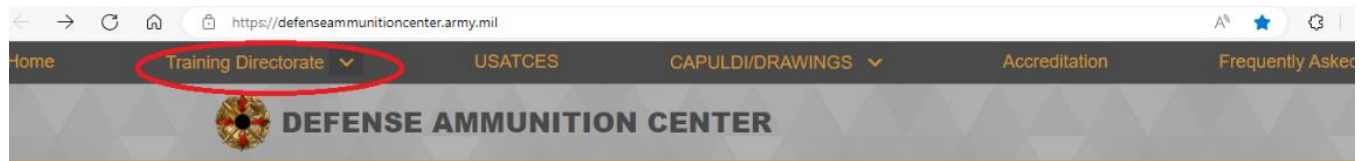

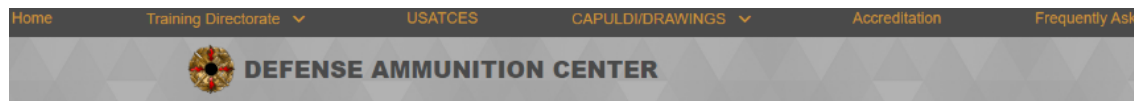

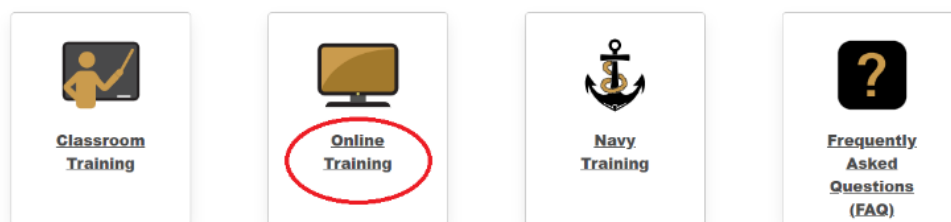


Welcome to Training Directorate

The U.S. Army Defense Ammunition Center is the proponent for this course.

1. COURSE PURPOSE/SCOPE:

PURPOSE: Certification training is provided IAW DoDI 5160.68, AR 385-10, and DA PAM 385-64 to personnel directly involved in hands-on exposure to ammunition and explosives (A&E) items and/or operations.

SCOPE: This course satisfies mandatory certification and refresher training requirements for personnel directly involved in hands-on exposure to A&E items and/or operations as prescribed by DoD 5160.68, AR 385-10, and DA PAM 385-64. Course content includes a review of regulatory guidance applicable to the safe conduct of A&E operations, as well as a comprehensive review of A&E classes and characteristics, and safe handling procedures and explosives safety requirements for the receipt, storage, maintenance, demilitarization, and issue of ammunition at U.S. Army installations.

2. COURSE INFORMATION:

- Exam Passing Score: **75% or higher**
