

- INSTALL EACH HORIZONTAL STRAP TO ENCIRCLE A LAYER OF BOXES ON THE PALLET. NOTE THAT THE STRAPS WILL BE LOCATED AS DIMENSIONED, NEAR THE TOP OF EACH LAYER. HORIZONTAL STRAPS MUST BE TENSIONED AND SEALED PRIOR TO APPLICATION OF TIEDOWN STRAPS.
- INSTALL EACH TIEDOWN STRAP TO PASS UNDER THE DECK/ INSTALL EACH TIEDOWN STRAP TO PASS UNDER THE DET STRINGER BOARDS OF THE PALLET. NOTE THAT THE STRAPS WILL BE LOCATED AS DIMENSIONED, NEAR THE SIDE CLEATS OF THE END PANELS OF THE BOX. TIEDO STRAPS WILL NOT BE APPLIED UNTIL THE HORIZONTAL TIEDOWN STRAPS HAVE BEEN TENSIONED AND SEALED


