

- C. THE LOAD STRAPS MUST BE PRE-POSITIONED ON THE PALLET DECK PRIOR TO PLACING BOXES ON THE PALLET. LOAD STRAPS MUST BE TENSIONED AND SEALED PRIOR TO APPLICATION OF TIEDOWN STRAPS.
- D. INSTALL EACH TIEDOWN STRAP TO PASS UNDER THE DECK/STRINGER BOARDS OF THE PALLET AND TO BE LOCATED AS SHOWN. TIEDOWN STRAPS WILL NOT BE APPLIED UNTIL THE LOAD STRAPS HAVE BEEN TENSIONED AND SEALFD.
