



GENERAL NOTES

- A. THIS APPENDIX CANNOT STAND ALONE BUT MUST BE USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE BASIC UNITIZATION PROCEDURES DRAWING 19-48-4116-20PA1002. TO PRODUCE AN APPROVED UNIT LOAD, ALL PERTINENT PROCEDURES, SPECIFICATIONS AND CRITERIA SET FORTH WITHIN THE BASIC DRAWING WILL APPLY TO THE PROCEDURES DELINEATED IN THIS APPENDIX. ANY EXCEPTIONS TO THE BASIC PROCEDURES ARE SPECIFIED IN THIS APPENDIX.
- B. DIMENSIONS, CUBE AND WEIGHT OF A PALLET UNIT WILL VARY SLIGHTLY DEPENDING UPON THE ACTUAL DIMENSIONS OF THE BOXES AND THE WEIGHT OF THE SPECIFIC ITEM BEING UNITIZED.
- C. THE LOAD STRAPS MUST BE PRE-POSITIONED ON THE PALLET DECK PRIOR TO PLACING BOXES ON THE PALLET. LOAD STRAPS WILL NOT BE APPLIED UNTIL THE TIEDOWN STRAPS HAVE BEEN TENSIONED AND SEALED.
- D. INSTALL EACH TIEDOWN STRAP TO PASS UNDER THE DECK/STRINGER BOARDS OF THE PALLET AND TO BE LOCATED AS SHOWN. TIEDOWN STRAPS MUST BE TENSIONED AND SEALED PRIOR TO THE APPLICATION OF THE LOAD STRAPS
- E. THE FOLLOWING AMC DRAWINGS ARE APPLICABLE FOR OUTLOADING AND STORAGE OF THE ITEMS COVERED BY THIS APPENDIX.

- G. IF ITEMS COVERED HEREIN ARE UNITIZED PRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF THIS APPENDIX, THE BOXES NEED NOT BE REUNITIZED SOLELY TO CONFORM TO THIS APPENDIX.
- H. THE UNITIZATION PROCEDURES DEPICTED HEREIN MAY ALSO BE USED FOR UNITIZING BIMM CARTRIDGES WHEN IDENTIFIED BY DIFFERENT NATIONAL STOCK NUMBERS (NSN) THAN WHAT IS SHOWN ON PAGE 2, PROVIDED THE BOX PACK DOES NOT VARY FROM WHAT IS DELINEATED HEREIN. THE EXPLOSIVE CLASSIFICATION OF OTHER ITEMS MAY BE DIFFERENT THAN WHAT IS SHOWN.
- J. WHEN THE UNIT LOAD DEPICTED AT LEFT IS TO BE USED FOR UNITIZING MARINE CORPS AMMUNITION, TWO LAYERS OF BOXES MUST BE OMITTED, TIEDOWN STRAP LENGTHS MUST BE DECREASED TO 13'-10", AND LOAD STRAP LENGTHS MUST BE DECREASED TO 16'-10", SPACER ASSEMBLY VERTICAL PIECES MUST BE SHORTENED TO 32-1/2" AND ONE HORIZONTAL PIECE MUST BE OMITTED. THIS WILL RESULT IN AN OVERALL UNIT HEIGHT OF 38-3/4", A GROSS UNIT WEIGHT OF 1,740 POUNDS, AND A UNIT CUBE OF 58.9 CUBIC FEET. ADDITIONALLY, THE UNIT MAY BE MODIFIED AS DESCRIBED WHEN BEING SHIPPED BY MILVAN OR SIDE OR END OPENING INTERMODAL FREIGHT CONTAINER. THE DETERMINATION TO REDUCE THE LOAD BY A LAYER FOR TRANSPORTATION WILL BE MADE BY THE RESPONSIBLE COMMAND AND WILL BE BASED UPON ECONOMICS OF TRANSPORTATION AND HANDLING.
- K. THE 61-1/8" WIDTH DIMENSION OF THE LOAD DEPICTED AT LEFT IS AN EXCEPTION TO THE BASIC PROCEDURES. HOWEVER, THE EXCEPTION IS NECESSARY FOR THE AMMUNITION PACK COVERED BY THIS APPENDIX TO MOST EFFECTIVELY GET AN ACCEPTABLE, COMPACT AND SOUND PALLET UNIT.
- J. THE STYLE 1B PALLET DELINEATED IN THE DETAIL AT LEFT NEED NOT HAVE CHAMFERS OR STRAP SLOTS AS SPECIFIED WITHIN MILITARY SPECIFICATION MIL-P-15011 WHEN USED FOR THE UNITIZATION OF ITEMS COVERED BY THIS APPENDIX.
