



- C. THE LOAD STRAPS WILL BE THREADED THROUGH THE STRAP SLOTS OF A PALLET. LOAD STRAPS MUST BE TENSIONED AND SEALED PRIOR TO APPLICATION OF TIEDOWN STRAPS.
- D. INSTALL EACH TIEDOWN STRAP TO PASS UNDER THE TOP DECK BOARDS OF THE PALLET AND TO BE LOCATED AS SHOWN. TIEDOWN STRAPS WILL NOT BE APPLIED UNTIL THE LOAD STRAPS HAVE BEEN TENSIONED AND SEALED.
- E. THE FOLLOWING DARCOM DRAWINGS ARE APPLICABLE FOR OUT-LOADING AND STORAGE OF THE ITEMS COVERED BY THIS APPENDIX.
