



 AN APPROVED UNIT LOAD, ALL PERTINENT PROCEDURES, TO PRODUCE AN APPROVED UNIT LUND, ALL PERTINENT PHOLEDURES, SPECIFICATIONS AND CRITERIA SET FORTH WITHIN THE BASIC ORAWING WILL APPLY TO THE PROCEDURES DELINEATED IN THIS APPENDIX. ANY EXCEPTIONS TO THE BASIC PROCEDURES ARE SPECIFIED IN THIS APPENDIX.
- DIMENSIONS, CUBE AND WEIGHT OF A PALLET UNIT WILL VARY SLIGHTLY DEPENDING UPON THE ACTUAL DIMENSIONS OF THE BOXES AND THE WEIGHT OF THE SPECIFIC ITEM BEING UNITIZED.
- THE LOAD STRAPS MAY BE THREADED THROUGH THE STRAP SLOTS OF A PALLET OR PRE-POSITIONED ON THE PALLET DECK PRIOR TO PLACING BOXES ON THE PALLET. LOAD STRAPS WILL NOT BE APPLIED UNTIL TIEDOWN STRAPS HAVE BEEN TENSIONED AND SEALED.
- INSTALL EACH TIEDOWN STRAP TO PASS UNDER THE TOP DECK BOARDS OF THE PALLET. TIEDOWN STRAPS MUST BE TENSIONED AND SEALED PRIOR TO APPLICATION OF LOAD STRAPS.

- THE UNITIZATION PROCEDURES DEPICTED HEREIN MAY ALSO BE USED FOR UNITIZING HAND GRENADES WHEN IDENTIFIED BY DIFFERENT NATIONAL STOCK NUMBERS (NSN) THAN WHAT IS SHOWN ON PAGE 2, PROVIDED THE BOX PACK DOES NOT VARY FROM WHAT IS DELINEATED HEREIN. THE EXPLOSIVE CLASSIFICATION OF OTHER ITEMS MAY BE DIFFERENT THAN NWOHZ 2I TAHW
 - WHEN THE UNIT LOAD DEPICTED AT LEFT IS TO BE USED FOR UNITIZING MARINE CORPS AMMUNITION, ONE LAYER OF BOXES MUST BE OMITTED, TIEDOWN STRAP LENGTHS MUST BE DECREASED TO 13'-6', AND LOAD STRAP LENGTHS MUST BE DECREASED TO 14'-3'. THIS VILL RESULT IN AN OVERALL UNIT HEIGHT OF 38', A GROSS UNIT WEIGHT OF 1,152 POUNDS, AND A UNIT CUBE OF 42.2 CUBIC FEET. ADDITIONALLY, THE UNIT MAY BE MODIFIED AS DESCRIBED WHEN BEING SHIPPED BY MILVAN OR COMMERCIAL INTERMODAL FREIGHT CONTAINER. THE DETERMINATION TO REDUCE THE LOAD BY A LAYER FOR TRANSPORTATION WILL BE MADE BY THE RESPONSIBLE COMMAND AND WILL BE BASED UPON ECONOMICS OF TRANSPORTATION AND WHEN THE UNIT LOAD DEPICTED AT LEFT IS TO BE USED BASED UPON ECONOMICS OF TRANSPORTATION AND HANDI TNG.
- K. THE 41-5/8" LENGTH DIMENSION OF THE UNIT DEPICTED AT LEFT IS AN EXCEPTION TO THE BASIC PROCEDURES. HOWEVER, THE EXCEPTION IS NECESSARY FOR THE AMMUNITION PACK COVERED BY THIS APPENDIX TO MOST EFFECTIVELY GET AN ACCEPTABLE, COMPACT AND SOUND
- THE STYLE 1A PALLET DELINEATED IN THE DETAIL AT LEFT NEED NOT HAVE CHAMFERS OR STRAP SLOTS AS SPECIFIED WITHIN MILITARY SPECIFICATION MIL-P-15011 WHEN USED FOR THE UNITIZATION OF ITEMS COVERED BY THIS APPENDIX.
