

ANY EXCEPTIONS TO THE BASIC PROCEDURES ARE SPECIFIED IN THIS APPENDIX.
- DIMENSIONS, CUBE AND WEIGHT OF A PALLET UNIT WILL VARY SLIGHTLY DEPENDING UPON THE ACTUAL DIMENSIONS OF THE BOXES AND THE WEIGHT OF THE SPECIFIC ITEM BEING UNITIZED.
- c. THE LOAD STRAPS MAY BE THREADED THROUGH THE STRAP SLOTS OF A PALLET OR PRE-POSITIONED ON THE PALLET DECK PRIOR TO PLACING BOXES ON THE PALLET. LOAD STRAPS MUST BE TENSIONED AND SEALED PRIOR TO APPLICATION OF TIEDOWN STRAPS.
- INSTALL EACH TIEDOWN STRAP TO PASS UNDER THE TOP DECK BOARDS OF THE PALLET AND TO BE LOCATED AS SHOWN. TIEDOWN STRAPS WILL NOT BE APPLIED UNTIL THE LOAD STRAPS HAVE BEEN TENSIONED AND SEALED. D.

- IF ITEMS COVERED HEREIN ARE UNITIZED PRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF THIS APPENDIX, THE BOXES NEED NOT BE REUNITIZED SOLELY TO CONFORM TO THIS APPENDIX.
- THE UNITIZATION PROCEDURES DEPICTED HEREIN MAY ALSO BE USED FOR UNITIZING SMOKE POTS WHEN IDENTIFIED BY DIFFERENT NATIONAL STOCK NUMBERS (NSN.) THAN WHAT IS SHOWN ON THE TITLE PAGE, PROVIDED THE BOX PACK DOES NOT VARY FROM WHAT IS DELINEATED HEREIN. THE EXPLOSIVE CLASSIFICATION OF OTHER ITEMS MAY BE DIFFERENT THAN
- WHEN THE UNIT LOAD DEPICTED AT LEFT IS TO BE USED FOR UNITIZING MARINE CORPS AMMUNITION, 1 LAYER OF BOXES MUST BE OMITTED, TIEDOWN STRAP LENGTHS MUST BE DECREASED TO 11'-6", AND LOAD STRAP LENGTHS MUST BE DECREASED TO 13'-6". THIS WILL RESULT IN AN OVER-ALL UNIT HEIGHT OF 31-3/4", A GROSS UNIT WEIGHT OF 1,200 LBS, AND A UNIT CUBE OF 31.8 CU FT. ADDITION ALLY, THE UNIT LOAD MAY BE MODIFIED AS DESCRIBED WHEN BEING SHIPPED BY MILVAN OR COMMERCIAL DETERMINATION TO REDUCE THE INTERMODAL FREIGHT CONTAINER. THE DETERMINATION TO REDUCE THE LOAD BY A LAYER FOR TRANSPORTATION WILL BE MADE BY THE RESPONSI-BLE COMMAND AND WILL BE BASED UPON ECONOMICS OF TRANSPORTA-TION AND HANDLING.
- THE STYLE TA PALLET DELINEATED IN THE DETAIL AT LEFT NEED NOT HAVE CHAMFERS OR STRAP SLOTS AS SPECIFIED WITHIN MILITARY SPECIFICATION MIL-P-15011 WHEN USED FOR THE UNITIZATION OF THE ITEMS COVERED BY THIS APPENDIX.
