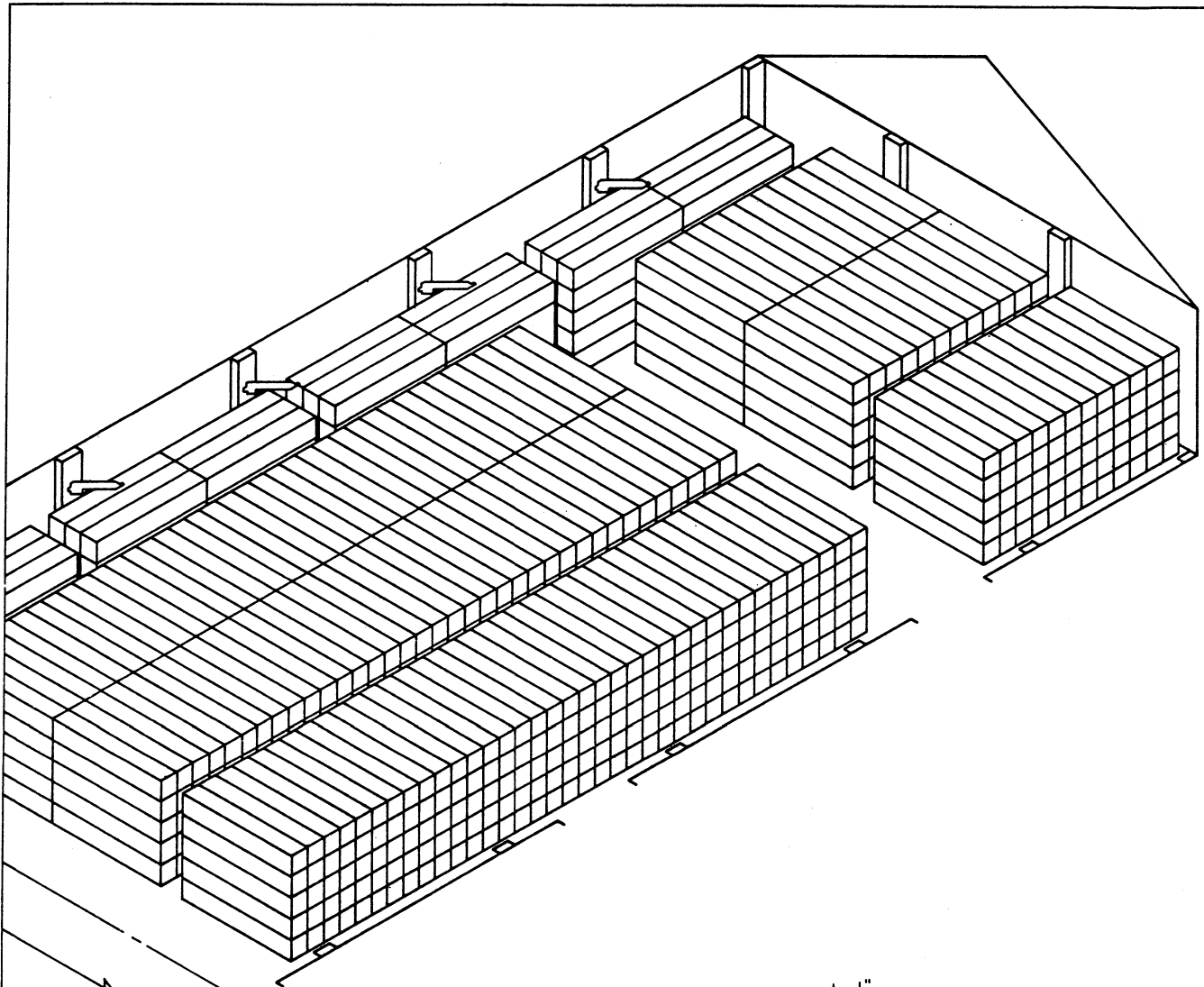

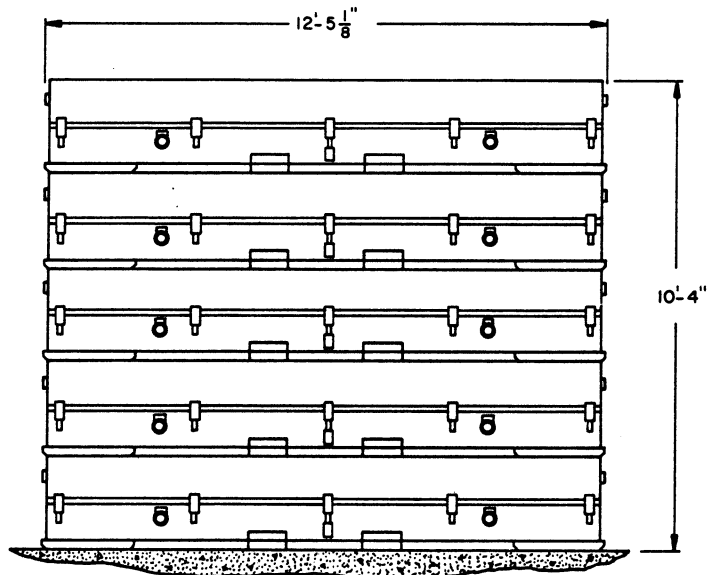

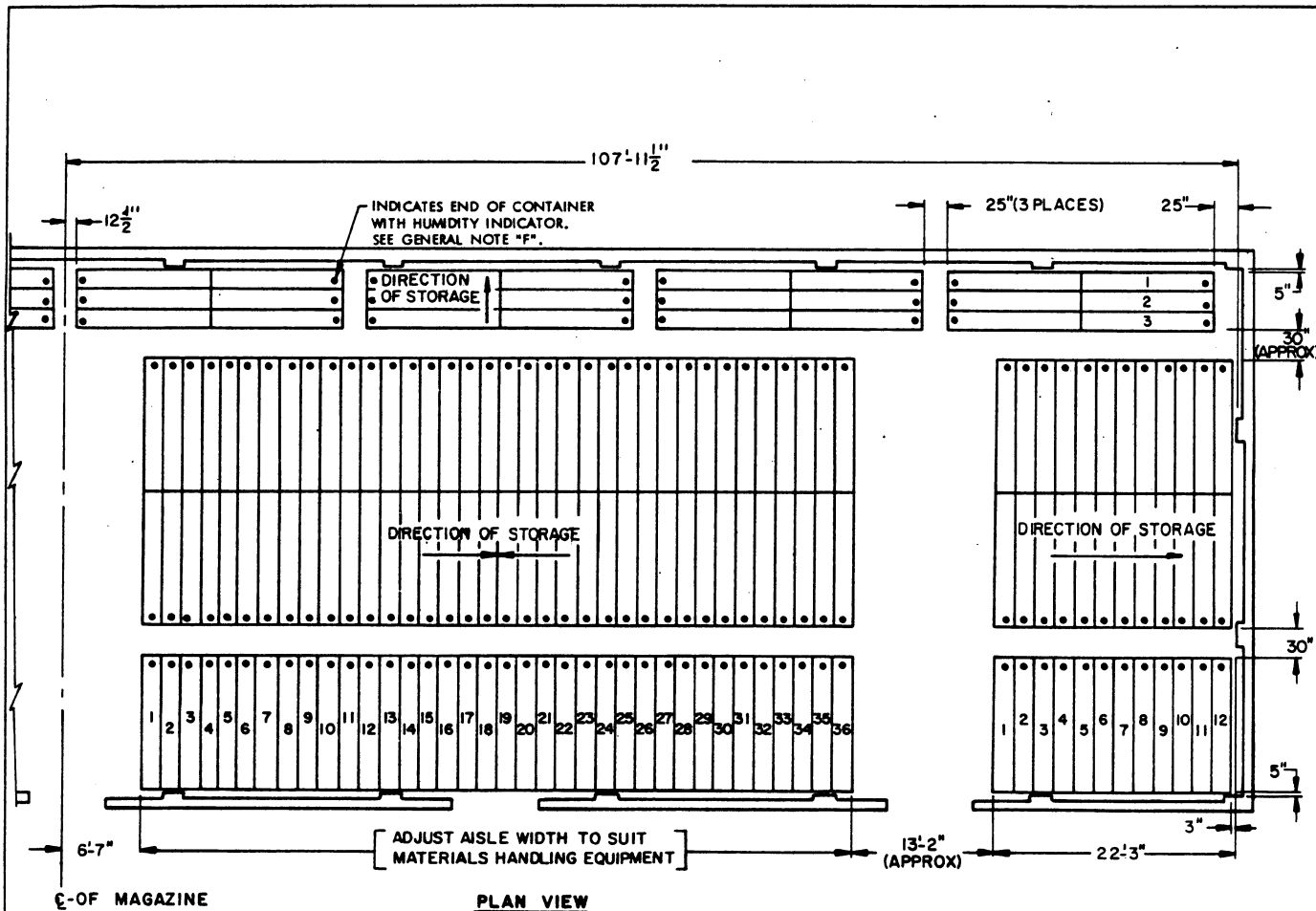
ISOMETRIC VIEW

GENERAL NOTES

- A. THIS DOCUMENT HAS BEEN PREPARED AND ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH AMCR 740-13, AND AUGMENTS TM 743-200-1 (CHAPTER 5).
- B. FOR DETAILS OF CNU 123/E CONTAINER, SEE DRAWING NO 12425.
CONTAINER DIMENSIONS ----- 149-1/8" LONG X 22" WIDE X 25" HIGH.
GROSS WEIGHT ----- 1,336 POUNDS (APPROX).
- C. CONTAINERS MUST NOT BE STACKED OVER FIVE HIGH.
- D. THE MAXIMUM FLOOR LOAD FOR A MAGAZINE AS PRESCRIBED BY LOCAL STANDARDS WILL NOT BE EXCEEDED.
- E. **CAUTION:** THE ALLOWABLE "EXPLOSIVE LIMIT" ESTABLISHED FOR A MAGAZINE IS NOT TO BE EXCEEDED. DEPENDING ON THE ITEM BEING STORED, THIS LIMITATION MAY REQUIRE A QUANTITY REDUCTION FROM THE STORAGE AS SHOWN.
- F. AISLE DIMENSIONS SHOWN HEREIN MAY BE ADJUSTED TO SUIT LOCAL CONDITIONS AND/OR AVAILABLE MATERIALS HANDLING EQUIPMENT (MHE); HOWEVER, A TWENTY-FOUR INCH (24") (MINIMUM) INSPECTION AISLE IS REQUIRED AT THE END OF THE CONTAINER EQUIPPED WITH A HUMIDITY INDICATOR.
